

# Mandatory Athletic Physical Forms for Grades 3-8

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in the St. Joseph Athletic Program. We are looking forward to the upcoming seasons of 2010-11 with anticipation and excitement. As you receive the registration paperwork, you will find that the costs for the SJS Athletic fees have not increased in several years. We are pleased to offer opportunities for all children to play at St. Joseph with reasonable fees.

As we enter into the 2010-11 athletic season, we are required to follow the Illinois School Code and the Diocese of Joliet policy regarding physical examinations for our athletes. **Each athlete is required to complete a yearly physical examination and return the attached form to St. Joseph School to be a member of the SJS teams and participate in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Clinics.** According to the law, the physical examination forms must be returned to St. Joseph School before any athlete may participate in practice or clinics or before the start of school.

Our Flag Football and Volleyball practices may begin as early as August 10<sup>th</sup>. Each athlete will need to complete the physical exam before attending practice. We encourage our families to take care of the physical examinations during the summer to make sure that each athlete is able to play at the start of the season.
